

9th Annual Residential Teacher Training Program

Learn about nonviolence (*ahimsa*) and its applications; observe the use of *ahimsa* principles both inside and outside the classroom; study Gandhi and learn how he practiced the concept of *ahimsa*; explore historical and living examples of *ahimsa* and discuss them with fellow participants; visit a variety of schools and interact with students, fellow teachers and management; discuss concepts like tolerance, equanimity, forgiveness, harmony, sharing, friendships and self-discipline, rational thinking, rehabilitating tough & slow learning kids along with culture and history of India.

This residential program is deigned for teachers, consultants, educators who wish to integrate practical nonviolence into their lives, classrooms and schools. Since its launch in 2012, so far 154 participants from different institutions have been trained through this program

The program provides an opportunity to visit schools, Gandhi museum. The fee covers lectures, vegetarian meals, a twin sharing room, entry fee of Ajanta Caves and in-land travel in India associated to the program.
