- Design studio appropriate for your classification (tailoring, knitwear, collections)
- Any art history class (to count as the art history elective requirement)
- Any marketing class

VCU Programs

VCU in Italy: SRISA

Terms: Academic Year, Fall, Spring, Summer

This program gives students the opportunity to take a variety of arts, language, and culture courses in the home of the Renaissance, all taught in English. SRISA coursework offers highly personalized instruction and experiential learning, enhanced with an internship program and a range of extracurricular activities, including art exhibits, cultural seminars, beyond-the-classroom learning, guest lecturers, and museum visits.

VCU in Qatar: VCUQatar

Terms: Academic Year, Fall, Spring

The exchange program at [VCUQatar](#) is a unique opportunity to earn VCU credits while studying design in a fascinating location. You will have an insider's view of life in the gulf region and the rich culture that suffuses the area. The turquoise-blue waters of the Persian Gulf provide a picturesque backdrop for the constantly changing landscape of Doha.

As the first and only university in the U.K. to offer a degree program in fashion merchandise management, the University of Westminster serves as a great place for students interested in studying fashion merchandising.

International Student Exchange Program

Choose from over 300 universities around the world offering summer, semester and year-long programs. Apply to up to 10 institutions on a single application. ISEP offers two types of placements: ISEP Exchange (program fee based on VCU's in-state tuition, room and board) and ISEP Direct (program fee based on the host university's tuition, room and board).
