Instructions

Your Financial Aid Counselor will complete this worksheet with you so that you will be aware of the estimated financial aid that may be available for study abroad. Their signature is required on this form.
- In order to receive any aid that you are eligible for, you will need to submit the Summer Financial Aid Application. VCU Education Abroad will notify you when the summer aid application is available, and give you further instructions for submitting it.

Reminders

- The aid you receive for your study abroad program will be considered part of your 2016-2017 financial aid package.
- Confirm all financial aid prior to leaving for trip. Aid may not be disbursed until after the start of your program. For this reason, you should be prepared to pay for all program costs prior to travel in the event that your financial aid disburses later than expected.
- Upon registration for a study abroad program, you must know how you will cover the program costs.

Withdrawing from a program for financial reasons will NOT relieve you of your financial responsibility for the costs of your program.
